SCORE Maine provides free small business mentoring, as well as online and in-person workshops. Our Mentors serve clients at all stages of the business lifecycle, from pre-start to exit.

SCORE Maine embraced virtual connections, delivering client meetings and educational webinars on demand. As a result, clients accessed services when and where they wanted.

In 2023, SCORE Maine facilitated 4,289 client sessions - and delivered 101 online webinars and in-person workshops, helping educate 4,214 workshop attendees on topics ranging from e-commerce to funding. In 2023, SCORE Maine Certified Mentors helped create 360 new businesses and 1,652 jobs. Our client's success is our success - we've featured some of their stories in this report.






Who We Serve



Kelson's mission is to help humans use the ocean for good. For Toby, this means helping innovative companies produce food and energy from the ocean via open-ocean aquaculture and marine renewables. Kelson Marine develops and applies state-of-the-art simulation tools and numerical modeling approaches to accurately design and evaluate novel marine structures. They put their methods to the test by deploying prototypes under the ocean to validate structural designs, reduce risk, decrease costs, and maximize success.
















A Special Thank You to the Leadership Team Working on the Maine Tax Forum!
